Automation? What's in for me?



→ Saves operator time Standard jobs can be fully automated, the operators concentrate on challenging jobs

 \rightarrow Reduces errors

once set up the processes run automatically with repeatable results

 \rightarrow Higher throughput






Automatic process net and layout generation with Smart Automation and Prinect Signa Station

- \rightarrow The processing sequences are connected
- \rightarrow Depending on the respective product information,
 - a Smart Template turns into different process nets.
 - a Signa PPT turns into different imposition layouts









Improvements in Smart Automation in Prinect 2016 Work with predefined Layout

- → Some customers prefer working with dedicated, pre-defined imposition schemes (special finishing equipment)
- → An 'AddLayout'-Sequence in the Smart Template pulls the scheme defined in the product code



More improvements in Smart Automation in Prinect 2016

→ Canceled orders can be displayed to distinguish finished orders and those canceled by the customer

 \rightarrow Extended device selection in Smart Templates

→ Proof / Finishing use different devices that cannot be selected by print format: A preferred device can be selected for those work steps (Proof, Cutting, Folding, Stitching)


Automation in Prinect with PDF Automation Pack plus Remote Access

CUSTOMER can

- + make approvals and trigger next steps automatically (without move)
- + create new 'Job(s) from Template' (WebUI)
- + position pages himself (per upload, since 2012 also manual)
- \rightarrow all these steps then don't have to be done by the prepress operators
 - \rightarrow less work / more customer responsibility

Business Cards, Labels, Flyers, etc. from a Web Shop that shall be produced on a gang form \rightarrow w2p-Connector with Smart Automation and Ganging



- → Automated filling of gang pool by Smart Automation sorting by due date, paper, colors
- → Gang Assistant for semi-automatic creation of optimized gang forms from files in gang pool calculation based on run length, geometry, and cost parameters for press, plates, paper
- \rightarrow process steps of single jobs are considered



All other products (no 100% potential) are partly automated

- \rightarrow Orders are created via an MIS-JDF
- \rightarrow Group Template with customer specific set of base sequences is automatically drawn
- → This ensures that the correct customer sequences (e.g. Color Management settings, specific output settings, etc) are taken.
 With 'MIS-selection' there is no accidental mis-selection

Automation options for multiple product variations without Smart Automation

- \rightarrow Multiple pre-jobs with **hotfolders**
 - Complete process net including AddLayout + Automatic page assignment

 or Imposition Editor Layout
 - Manual data submission


